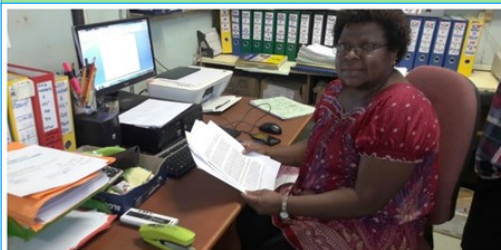

East Sepik is one of PCaB's new provinces for this year 2017 in which Mr Wesley Kilala is the current PCaB site Advisor providing support to ESP. Mr Kilala possessed knowledge and skills of PGAS software Applications while working in the accounts office environments using PGAS and being a trainer with the Finance Training Branch of the Department of Finance previously. These skills and knowledge are very helpful to provide much needed support to officers involved in PGAS at the sub national levels.

Highlighted in this article is the testimony of how PCaB Advisor has supported East Sepik PGAS Machinist Ms Angeline Ouyoumb.

*In the beginning she struggled to understand how to use the PGAS Payroll systems as she was never trained in Payroll, interestingly the Payroll training has never been delivered throughout the country on the assumption that PGAS will be phased out. Angeline had seen the Payroll Systems being used but did not directly participate in processing the payroll . The PCaB Advisor then assisted with self compiled PGAS notes and on-the-job training on how to process the payroll. The Notes are very instructive and with the verbal advice given Angeline is now processing the PGAS Payroll for the ESP without much assistance. Angeline is also one of the determined Provincial Finance Officers that is eager to learn and prosper in the Department of Finance. We need to continue to support our Provincial and District Finance Officers with PGAS until it is totally phased out.*
